(1871-1922)

Prince Kūhiō would have been King of Hawai'i had the Monarchy continued. He saw far into the future for the preservation and perpetuation of his people upon the land of their fathers . . . and through the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act passed by the Congress of the United States in 1921— provided for our people the land which is their life. On his deathbed he told a friend: *“E huliāmahi nā Hawai'i a ho'ā'o e 'ae like e like me ka mea hiki, i hiki ke loa'a ka ha'ina o ka pilikia nui, 'o ia ho'i ke ola o ka lāhui.- Hawaiians join together in unity and try to agree so that the answer to a large problem, the life of the race, can be found.”*

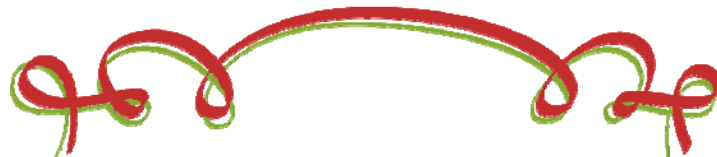
