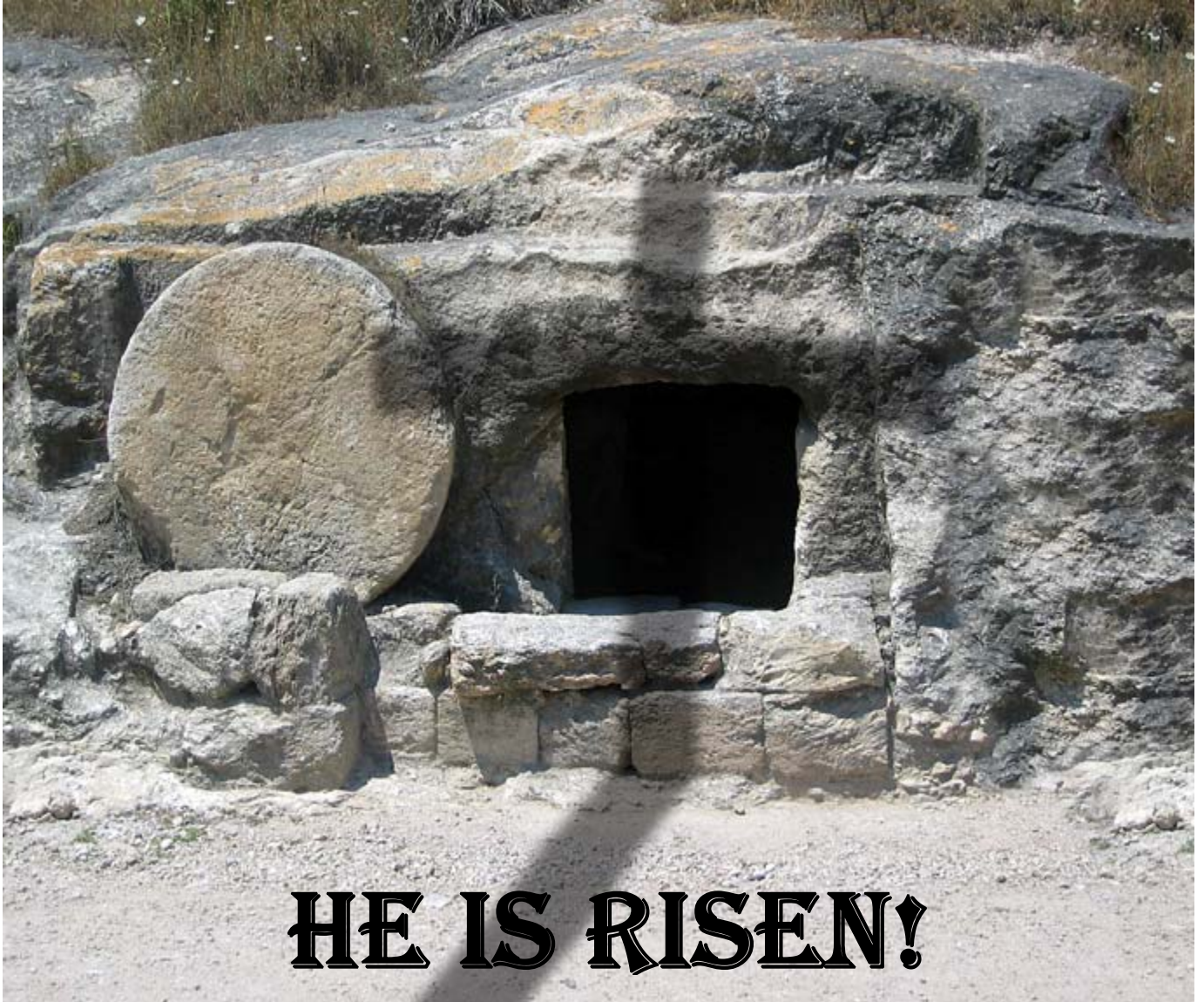

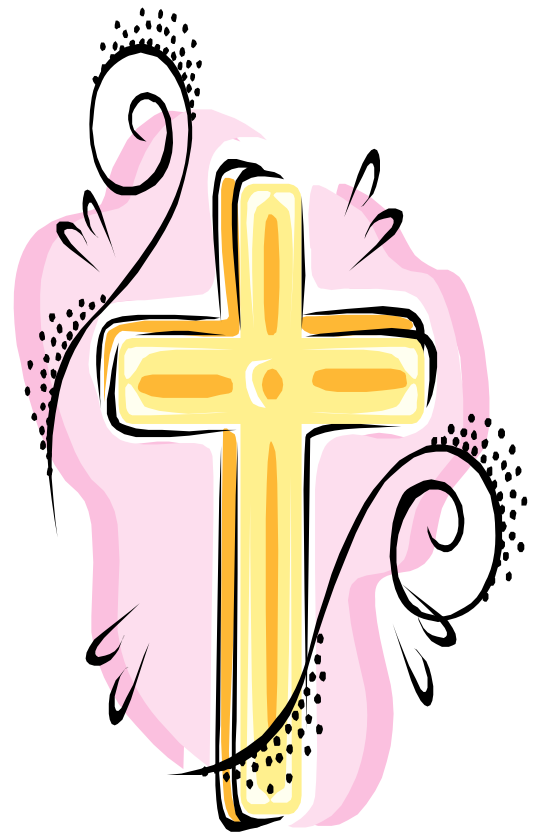

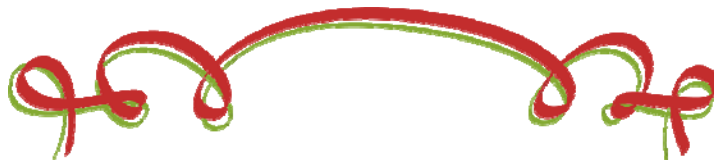

Would you like to go to the Holy Lands in October 2010?

Day 4-Oct. 4: There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise on the Sea of Galilee. Today we will walk in the steps of Jesus along the shores of the Galilee where Jesus did most of His miracles. We will begin our day with a visit to the recently excavated Jesus Boat, and then we board our replica Jesus "Wooden Boat" for our boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and includes sites of: Capernaum (Matt. 4:13), Mount of Beatitudes (Matt. 5-7), Tabgha (Feeding of 5000; Mark 6), Magdala (Matt. 15:39; Luke 8:2); and a special visit to the recently excavated Bethsaida site. We will finish the day with a Baptismal Service for those who wish, in the Jordan River. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.
