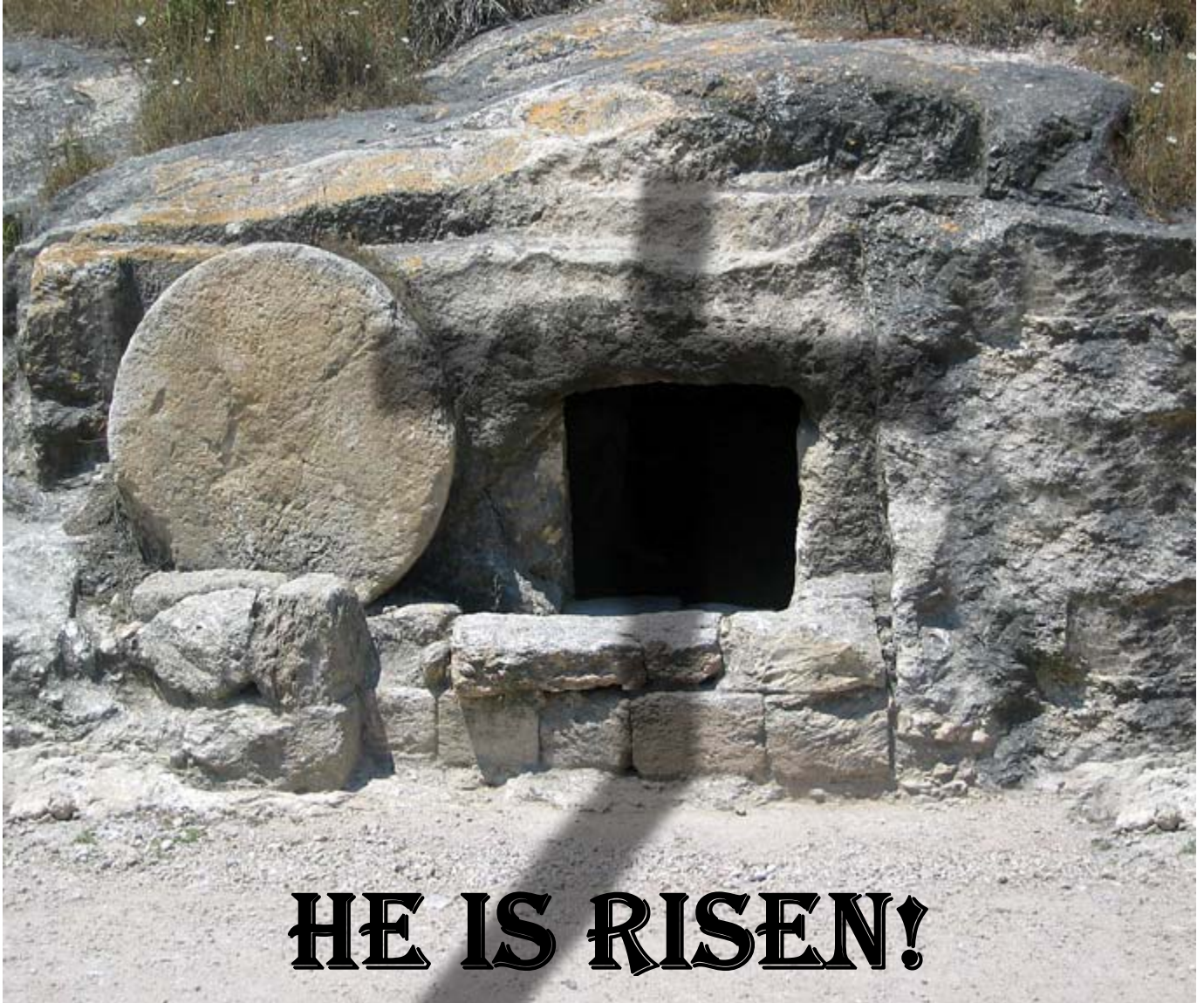

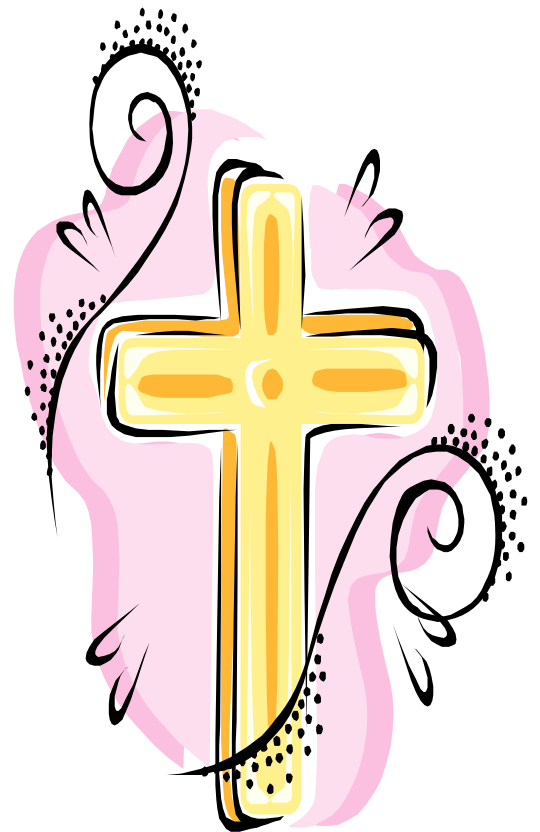

- 5 ‘Ōlelo maila ka anela i ua mau wahine lā, Mai maka‘u ‘olua, no ka mea, ua ‘ike au e ‘imi ana ‘olua iā Iesū i ka mea i kaulia ma ke ke‘a.
- 6 ‘A‘ole ia ma ‘ane‘i, no ka mea, ua ala a‘e ia e like me kāna ‘ōlelo ‘ana; e haele mai ‘olua e nānā i kahi i waiho ai o ka Haku.
- 7 E haele koke ‘olua e ha‘i aku i kāna po‘e haumāna, ua ala a‘e ia mai ka make mai; aia ho‘i, e hele aku ana ia ma mua o ‘oukou i Galilaia, ma laila ‘oukou e ‘ike aku ai iā ia. Eia ho‘i, ua ha‘i aku nō wau iā ‘olua.
- 8 Ho‘i koke akula lāua i waho o ka hale kupapa‘u me ka maka‘u a me ka ‘oli‘oli nui; a holo akula lāua e ha‘i aku i nā haumāna āna.
- 9 I ko lāua hele ‘ana aku e ha‘i i nā haumāna, aia ho‘i, hālāwai maila ‘o Iesū me lāua, ‘ī maila, Aloha ‘olua! Hele akula lāua, apo a‘ela ma kona wāwae, a ho‘omana akula iā ia.

- 1 After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.
- 2 There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it.
- 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow.
- 4 The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.
- 5 The angel said to the women, “Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified.
- 6 He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.

7 Then go quickly and tell his disciples: ‘He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.’ Now I have told you.”

8 So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples.

9 Suddenly Jesus met them “Greetings,” he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshipped him.

10 Then Jesus said to them, “Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me.”

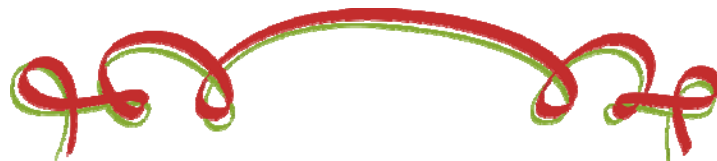
