**Announcements**

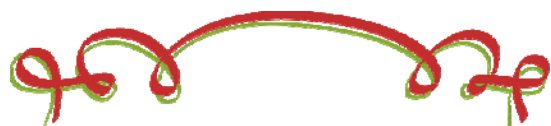

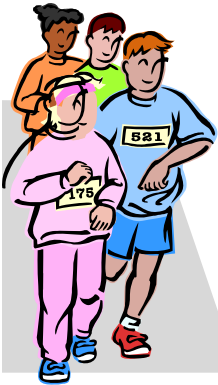
