Princess Pauahi left her estates for the education of native Hawaiian children, decreeing that all her teachers and trustees be Protestants; Christians, that the children be given instructions in morals by word and deed, that the children might become good and industrious men and women. She was the great-granddaughter and last direct heir of King Kamehameha I.

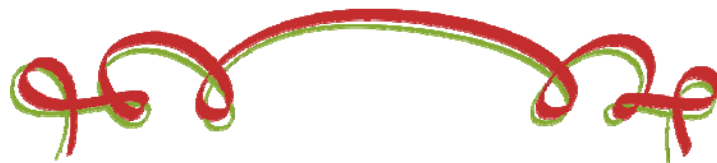
