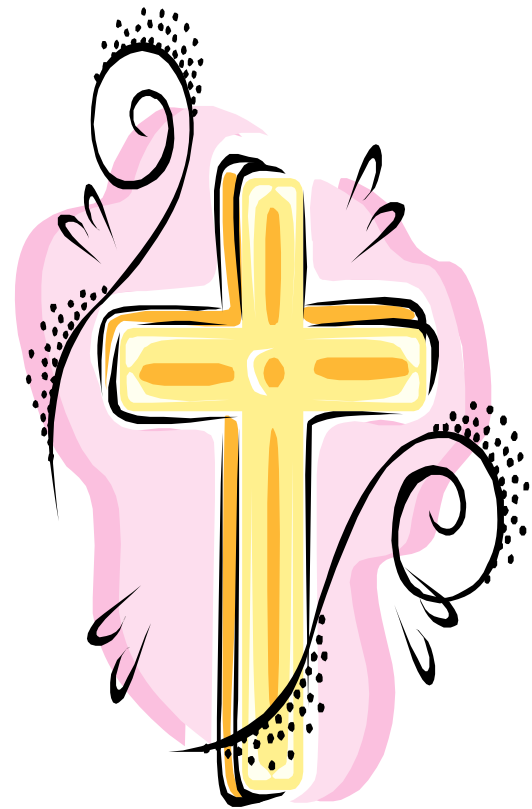

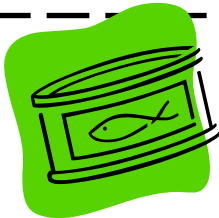

Mahalo to all who have contributed canned goods for distribution to our houseless community.

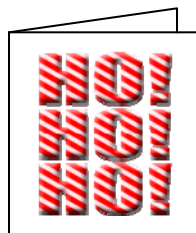
