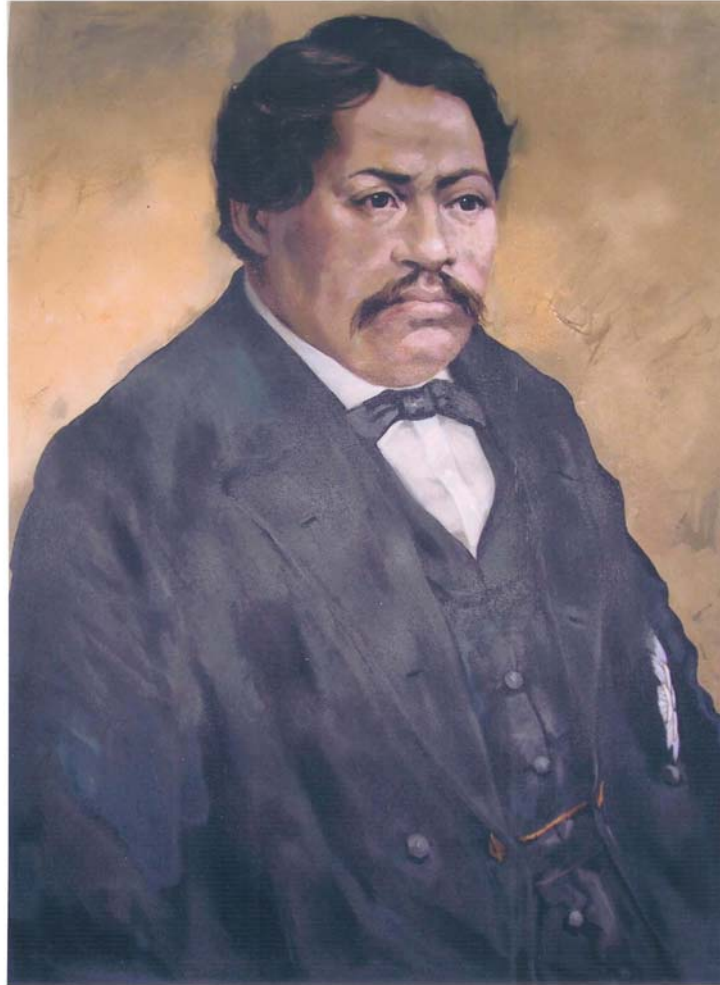

He was a pupil of our missionary teachers, Amos and Juliette Cooke. He later reigned from 1863 to 1872. He was a strong King of a strong government, who changed the constitution of Hawai`i its first unicameral legislature. During his reign, many ancient hula and kahuna rituals were revived.

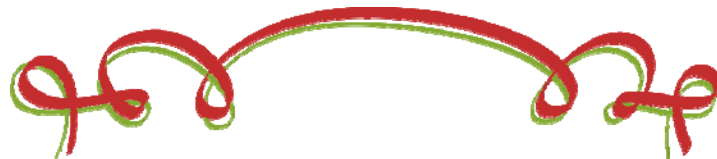
