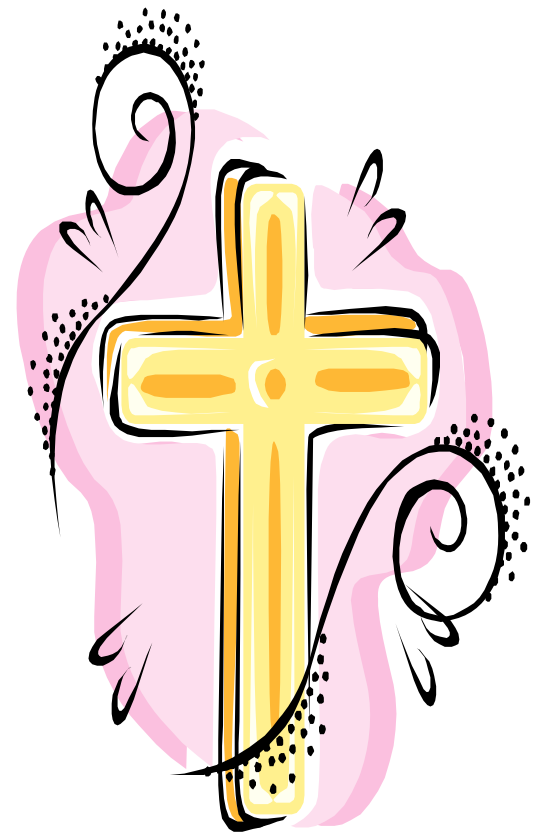

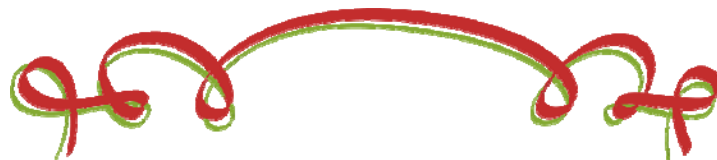

Would you like to go to the Holy Lands in October 2010?

Day 8-Oct. 8: We begin our day with a visit to the Church of Ascension, descend to Gethsemane with its ancient olive grove, and there visit the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will enter Jerusalem through the Dung gate, and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35 acre temple area purchased by King David. On this site now stands the Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in all Islam) and the El Aksa Mosque. This afternoon we will pass by Rachel's Tomb on the outskirts of Bethlehem, and view the Shepherd's Fields. For those interested you can visit the Church of the Nativity. Dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.
