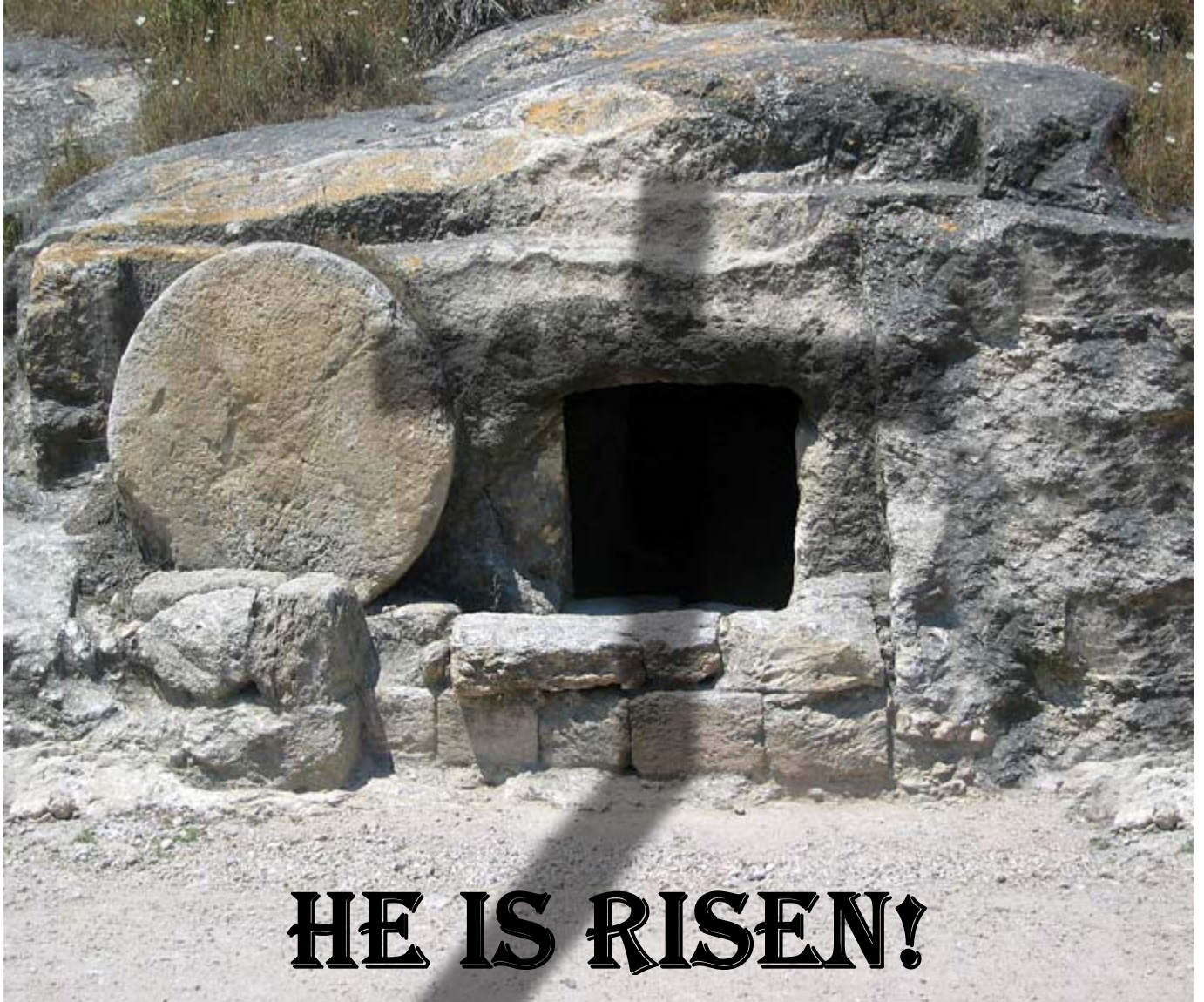

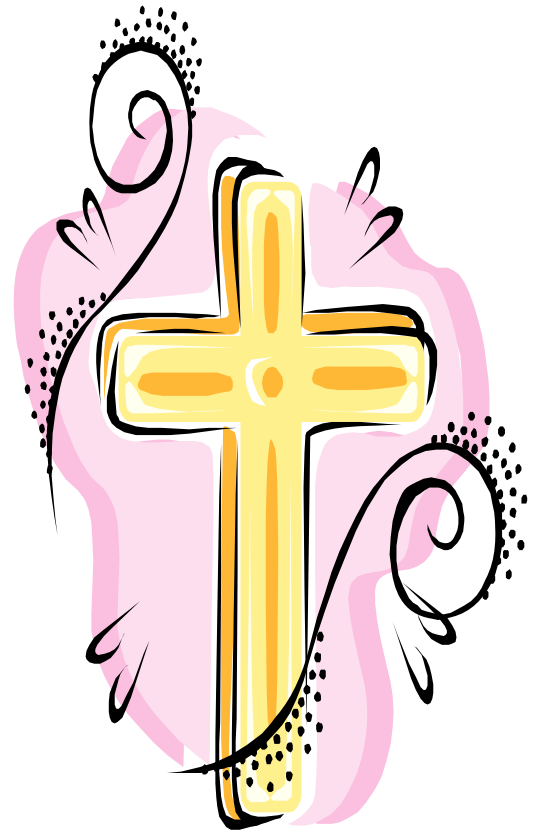

EARTH MONTH!**

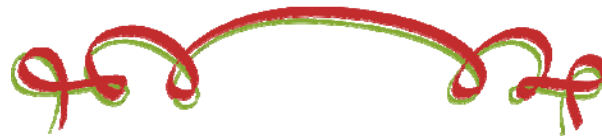
