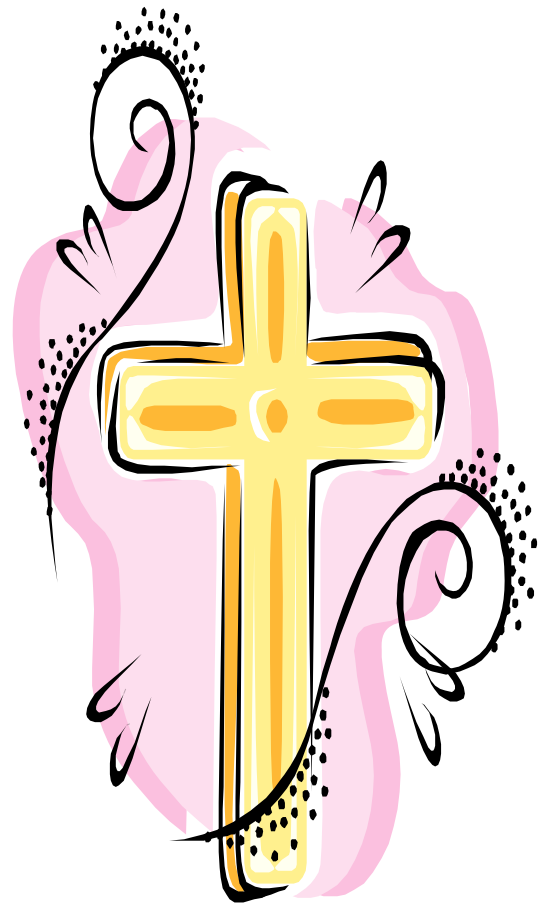

GLEEMENPLUS BIO

The *GleemenPlus* of Honolulu is a non-audition community choir whose beginnings started in 1917 as the Gleemen of Honolulu. In 1992, under the direction of Shigeru Hotoke, women were invited into the ensemble and the name was changed to The *GleemenPlus* of Honolulu. The choir has been under the direction of Mark Yasuhara since 2007. Most of its members have little to no musical background, but, they all love to sing. They are always looking for new members, so, if you are interested, please talk to one of their members at the conclusion of the service.

Mark Yasuhara holds a BE in Music from the University of Hawai‘i and placed 1st in the Pacific Regional’s Metropolitan and San Francisco Opera Auditions. He married his wife Diane in 1967, and both became international headliners in Christian concerts and recording ministry. They have fourteen albums to their credit and have appeared on several Billy Graham television crusades.

Koco Kawabuchi, born and raised in Japan, has played the piano since age 3. She has had extensive experience with choirs and music production, and most recently, in New York City.
