*PEOPLE:* As disciples of Jesus Christ, we are called to struggle against everything that leads us away from the love of God and neighbor. Repentance, fasting, prayer, study, and works of love help us return to that love. I invite you, therefore, to commit yourselves to love God and neighbor by confessing your sins and by asking God for strength to persevere in your Lenten discipline. Let us pray.

*KANANI:* **Most holy and merciful God: We confess to you and to one another, and to the whole communion of saints in heaven and on earth, that we have sinned by our own fault in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.**

*PEOPLE:* We have not loved you with all our hearts, and mind, and strength. We have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We have not forgiven others as we have been forgiven.

*PEOPLE:* Our negligence in prayer and worship and our failure to commend the faith that is in us.

**IVAN: We confess to you, O God.**

*PEOPLE:* Accept our repentance, O God, for the wrongs we have done. For our neglect of human need and suffering and our indifference to injustice and cruelty.

**KANANI: Accept our repentance, O God.**

*PEOPLE:* For all false judgments, for uncharitable thoughts toward our neighbors, and for our prejudice and contempt toward those who differ from us.

**IVAN: Accept our repentance, O God.**

*PEOPLE:* For our waste and pollution of your creation and our lack of concern for those who come after us.

*PEOPLE:* Restore us, O God, and let your anger depart from us.

## **“Ash Wednesday”**

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Lenten season, a 40 day period of fasting and spiritual preparation that leads us into Easter.

Ash Wednesday gets its name from the Ceremony of Ashes, a representation of the following scripture, “For you were made from dust, and to dust you shall return” (Genesis 3:19).

Traditionally ashes are prepared before the service by burning the palm or olive branches from Palm Sunday and grinding the ashes together with a little water or oil.

Ashes are then placed on the forehead of each worshiper as part of the act of confession and as a sign of mortality and penitence. The thumb of the priest or pastor is used to transfer the ashes to each participants forehead in the shape of a cross.

Following the Ceremony of Ashes, the Sacrament of Holy Communion is taken by the congregation.
