If you would like to find out more about the history of Kawaiaha 'o Church and its grounds, we invite you to join our Doorkeepers and Greeters for a brochure following the service.

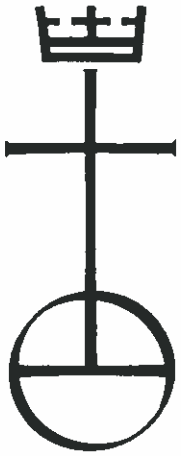

<sup>1</sup> Ma hope iho o kēia mau mea hō'ike hou maila 'o Iesū iā ia iho i nā haumāna ma ka moana wai 'o Tiberia. Pēnēia 'o ia i hō'ike ai. <sup>2</sup> Noho pū ihola 'o Simona Petero me Toma i kapa 'ia 'o Didumo, a me Natana'ela no Kāna i Galilaia, a me nā keiki a Zebedaiō, a me nā mea 'ē a'e 'elua o kāna po'e haumāna. <sup>3</sup> 'Ī akula 'o Simona Petero iā lākou, E hele ana au i ka lawai'a. 'Ī mai lākou iā ia, 'O mākou kekahi e hele pū me 'oe. Hele akula lākou, a e'e koke a'ela i ka moku: 'a'ohe mea i loa'a iā lākou ia pō. <sup>4</sup> A ao a'ela, kū maila 'o Iesū ma ke kapa; 'a'ole na'e i 'ike nā haumāna, 'o Iesū ia. <sup>5</sup> A laila nīnau maila 'o Iesū iā lākou, E nā pōki'i, 'a'ole a 'oukou wahi i'a? 'Ī akula lākou iā ia, 'A'ole. <sup>6</sup> 'Ī maila 'o ia iā lākou, E ku'u aku i ka 'upena ma ka 'ao'ao 'ākau o ka moku, a e loa'a iā 'oukou. No ia mea, ku'u ihola lākou, 'a'ole i hiki iā lākou ke huki mai ia i ka nui loa o nā i'a. <sup>7</sup> A laila, 'Ī akula ka haumāna a Iesū i aloha ai iā Petero, 'O ka Haku ia. A lohe a'ela 'o Simona Petero, 'o ka Haku ia, kā'ei a'ela ia i ke kapa, no ka mea, ua 'ōlohelohe ia, a lele ihola i ka moana wai. <sup>8</sup> A holo mai

nā haumāna i koe ma ka moku e kauō ana i ka ‘upena me ka i‘a, (no ka mea, ‘a‘ole lō‘ihi aku lākou mai ka ‘āina aku, ‘elua paha haneri kūbita.)<sup>9</sup> A pae lākou i uka, ‘ike akula lākou i ka lānahu ahi, a me ka i‘a i kau ‘ia ma luna, a me ka berena.<sup>10</sup> ‘Ī maila ‘o Iesū iā lākou, E lawe mai i ka i‘a i loa‘a iho nei iā ‘oukou.<sup>11</sup> Hele a‘ela ‘o Simona Petero, a huki mai i ka ‘upena i uka, ua piha i nā i‘a nui, ho‘okahi haneri a me kanalimakumamākolu; ‘a‘ole na‘e i moku ka ‘upena i ko lākou lehulehu ‘ana.<sup>12</sup> ‘Ī maila ‘o Iesū iā lākou, E hele mai e ‘ai. ‘A‘ole i ‘a‘a kekahi o nā haumāna e nīnau aku iā ia, ‘O wai ‘oe? Ua ‘ike nō lākou, ‘o ka Haku ia.<sup>13</sup> Hele maila ‘o Iesū, a lālau iholā i ka berena, a hā‘awi maila iā lākou, a me ka i‘a nō ho‘i.<sup>14</sup> ‘O ke kolu kēia o ko Iesū hō‘ike ‘ana iā ia iho i kāna po‘e haumāna, ma hope iho o kona ala hou ‘ana a‘e mai ka make mai.

### **John 21:1-14**

<sup>1</sup>Afterward Jesus appeared again to his disciples, by the Sea of Galilee.<sup>[a]</sup> It happened this way: <sup>2</sup>Simon Peter, Thomas (also known as Didymus<sup>[b]</sup>), Nathanael from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples were together.<sup>3</sup> “I’m going out to fish,” Simon Peter told them, and they said, “We’ll go with you.” So they went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught nothing.

<sup>4</sup>Early in the morning, Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realize that it was Jesus.

<sup>5</sup>He called out to them, “Friends, haven’t you any fish?”

“No,” they answered.

<sup>6</sup>He said, “Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some.” When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

<sup>7</sup>Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, “It is the Lord!” As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, “It is the Lord,” he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water. <sup>8</sup>The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards.<sup>[c]</sup> <sup>9</sup>When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.

<sup>10</sup>Jesus said to them, “Bring some of the fish you have just caught.” <sup>11</sup>So Simon Peter climbed back into the boat and dragged the net ashore. It was full



of large fish, 153, but even with so many the net was not torn. <sup>12</sup>Jesus said to them, "Come and have breakfast." None of the disciples dared ask him, "Who are you?" They knew it was the Lord. <sup>13</sup>Jesus came, took the bread and gave it to them, and did the same with the fish. <sup>14</sup>This was now the third time Jesus appeared to his disciples after he was raised from the dead.

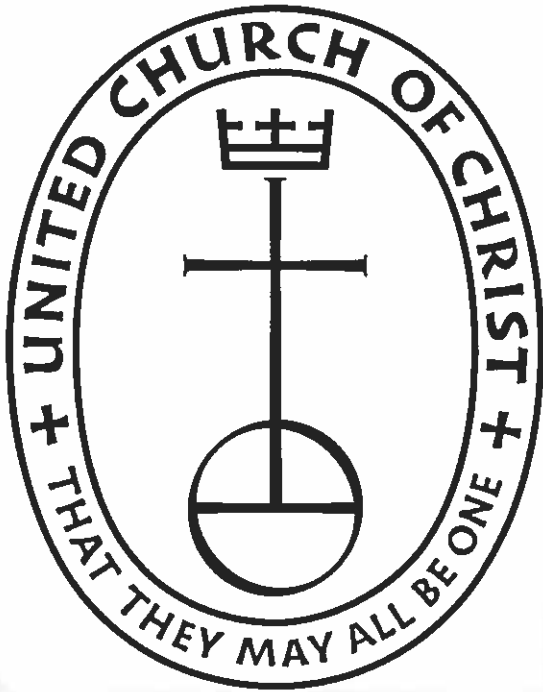
